Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** (a) The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority shall issue a monthly
- 3 water bill abatement to St. Croix residential and commercial customers receiving potable water
- 4 service in areas officially declared as being impacted by unsatisfactory levels of lead and copper
- 5 as provided in this section:

- 6 (1) The abatement amount must be equal to 50% of the customer's average water bill
- 7 for the months of May through October 2023.
- 8 (2) The abatement commences the first billing cycle after the enactment date of this act
- 9 and continues for five consecutive billing cycles, for a total of six billing cycles.

10 <u>BILL SUMMARY</u>
